Submission Guidelines

For Artists wishing to exhibit in the Craft Gallery

The Ropewalk welcomes submissions from makers working in any media and is measured against the following criteria:

- Artistic, aesthetic and innovative qualities
- Level of craftsmanship
- Compatibility with current stock
- Pricing considerations
- Ethical considerations
- Saleability

A submission should contain the following:

- 1) Up to 10 images of your current work indicating media, dimensions and price (digital images on CD for PC, photographs or jpeg email attachment)
- 2) Short CV/biography detailing education, recent exhibitions etc.
- 3) An artist's statement detailing concepts, themes of work etc
- 4) A technical statement outlining: processes; equipment; techniques; materials used and their origin of source. Please state if any part of your work is not made by you.
- 5) An outline of any activity you can provide: ie: workshop, demonstration etc
- 6) Full contact details including daytime telephone number and email address

Please enclose a stamped self-addressed envelope if you wish us to return your submission.

Selection meetings are held quarterly so please do not expect an immediate response but we will acknowledge receipt by email.

The selection committee reserve the right to select artists and makers who meet the standards set by The Ropewalk and are approved by a majority at the selection meeting.

If you are successful, you will be issued with a contract. Work is sold on a sale or return basis with The Ropewalk taking a 40% commission (+ VAT) on goods sold. Payments are made monthly once the balance sold exceeds £50.

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
