Format

- Submissions must be in English, typed, double-spaced and in 12 point font
- Submissions must show no name, address or identifying marks other than the title.
- Each submission must be accompanied by a completed form.
- Submissions will not be returned, please keep a copy.
- No corrections can be made after submission
- Entry fees are non-refundable.
